HOW TO FIND MY CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORDS



IF YOU DO NOT HAVE YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORDS, YOU CAN OBTAIN AN OFFICIAL COPY FROM A FEW DIFFERENT PLACES.

YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL

Most schools keep vaccination records on file. Schools may keep records for a year or two after a student leaves or graduates. Contact your child's school for more information.

YOUR CHILD'S DOCTOR OR CLINIC

Doctors and health clinics keep records of vaccines that they give to your child. Keep in mind that they may save records for only a few years. If your child has been vaccinated at different locations, you may have to contact each of them to get your child's records.

YOUR STATE'S IMMUNIZATION REGISTRY

Contact the Immunization Information Services (IIS) in your state or the state where your child received their last vaccine to see if they have your child's records and learn how to request an official copy.
