

I CAN'T REMEMBER IF MY CHILD GOT A VACCINE AND HAVE NO RECORD. IS IT SAFE TO REPEAT VACCINES?

In these situations, getting an extra dose of vaccine when an immunization history is unknown is recommended by national authorities (e.g., Centers for Disease Control, Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices, American Academy of Pediatrics, American Academy of Family Physicians) to make sure that children are protected against dangerous diseases.

It is better to ensure protection by getting the vaccine than risk leaving your child unprotected.

Talk to your child's doctor about how to protect your child.
