


COVID-19 Case and Hospitalization Data

9.1% Test Positivity (Most Recent 7-Day Rate) 1.1% Decrease From 7 Days Prior




Hospital Admissions:





COVID-19 Vaccine Equity Goals

Happy New Year!

As the New Year starts, we have six months to achieve our COVID-19 vaccine equity goals. As a reminder, below you will find our goals for 2024:

By June 2024, 25% of SBC residents >65 years old will be vaccinated, and there will be less than 3% difference in vaccination rates among racial and ethnic groups.

By June 2024, 15% of children 6 months to 5 years old will be vaccinated, and there will be less than 3% difference in vaccination rates among racial and ethnic groups.

Vaccination data as of 01/19/2024 shows:

- Vaccination rates for adults >65 years old have increased. 21.6% of Black/African American adults are vaccinated, but Asian (16.5%) and Latinx (13.8%) counterparts are trailing.
- Overall, the 6 months to 5 year old age group has not reached a 1% vaccination rate, and Black/African American and Latinx children are among those least vaccinated.
