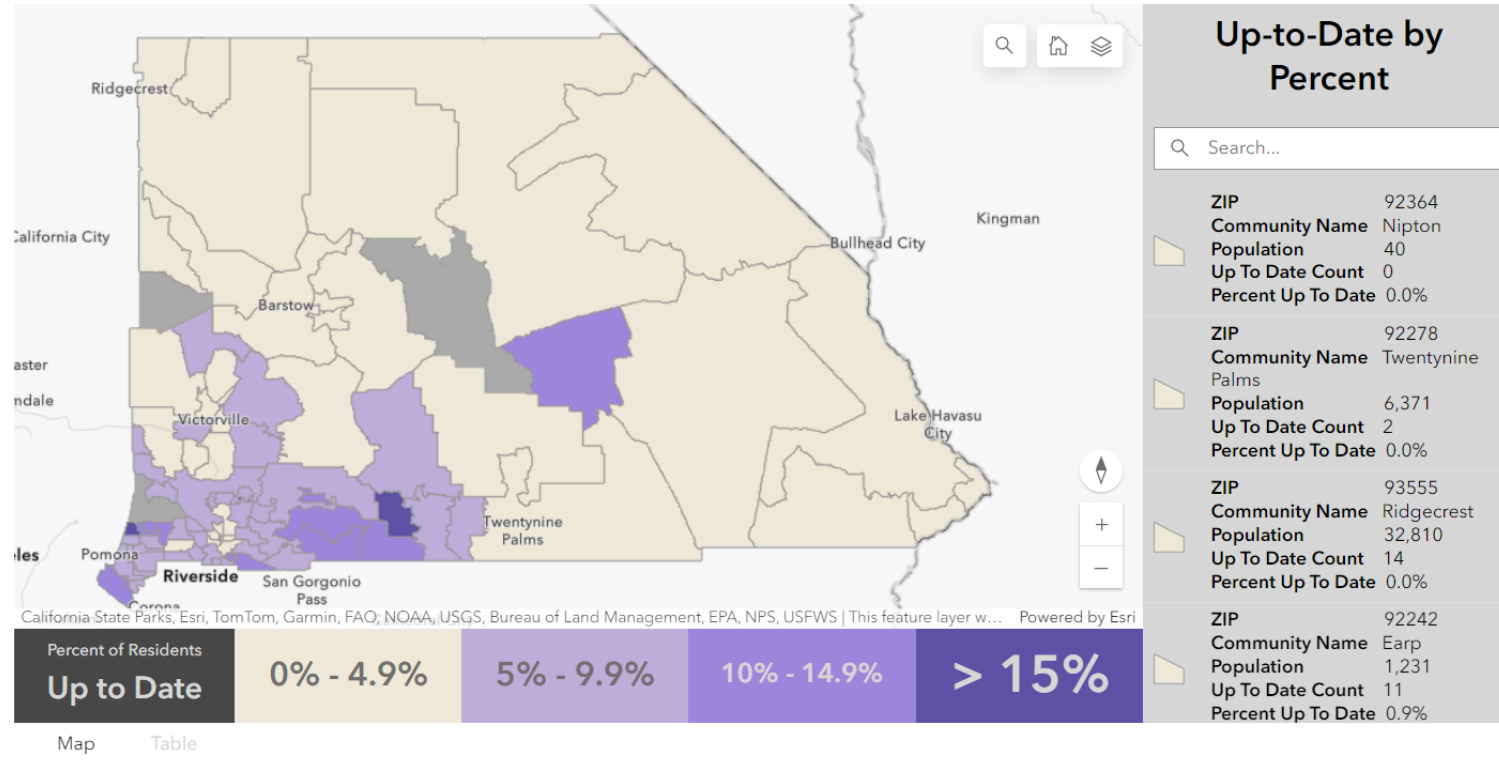

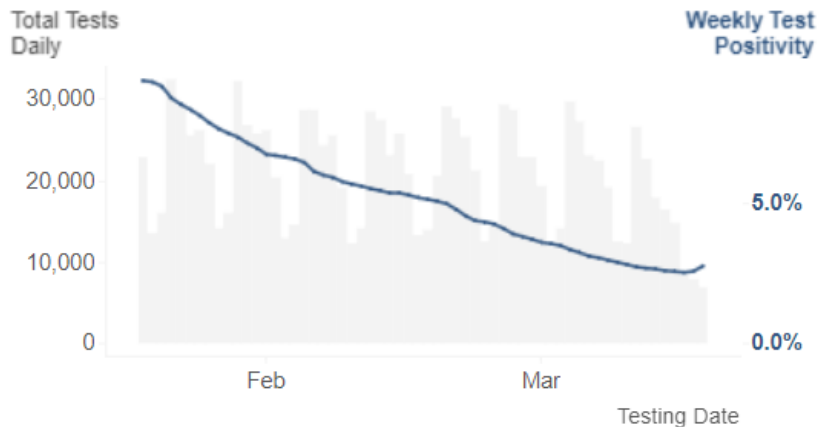

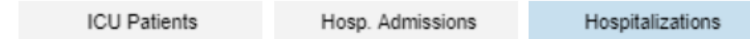

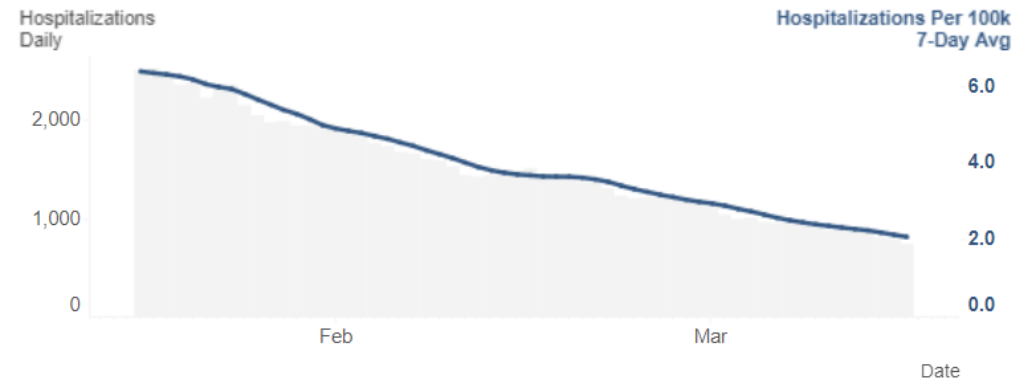

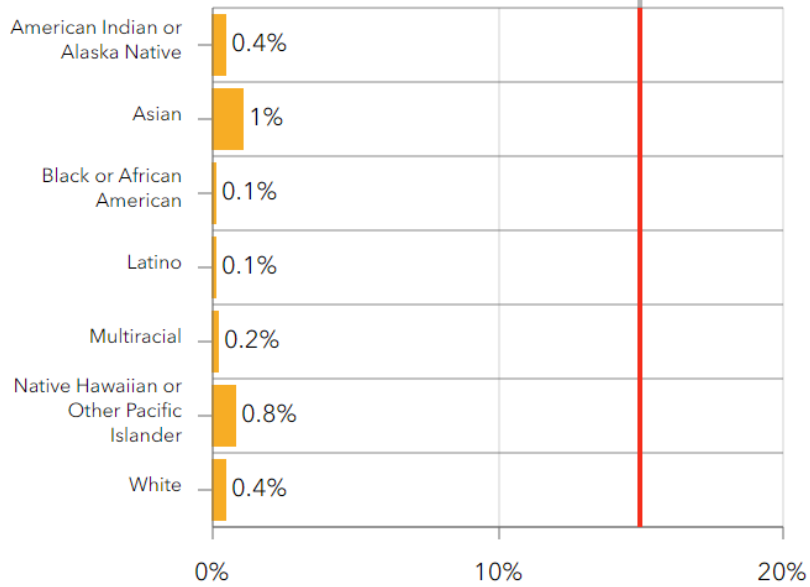

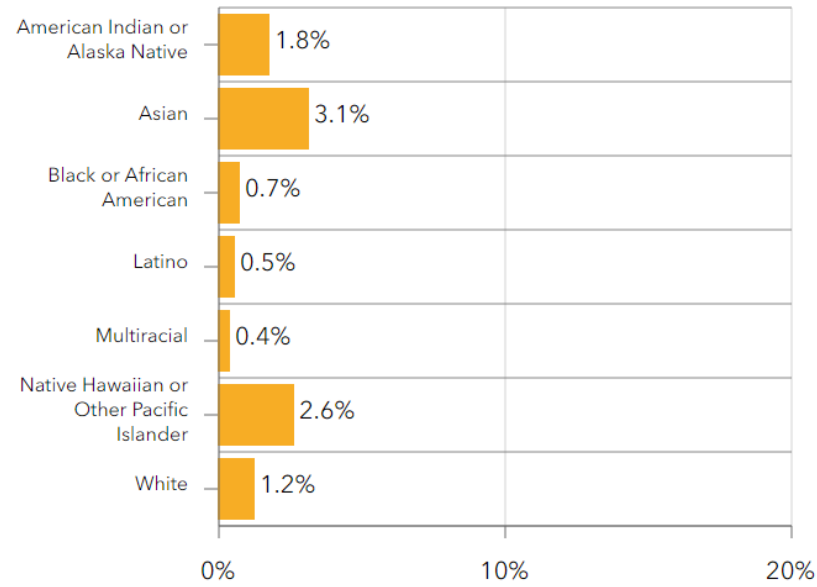
County Vaccination Data by Age and Race/Ethnicity

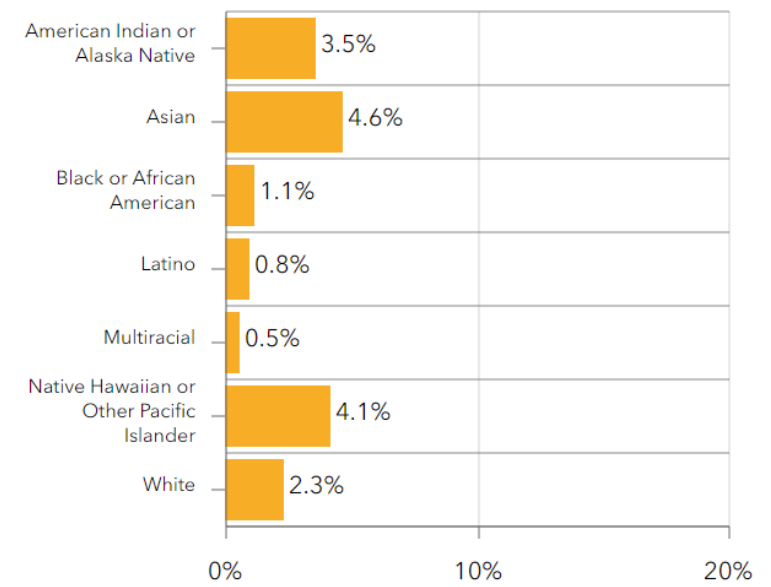

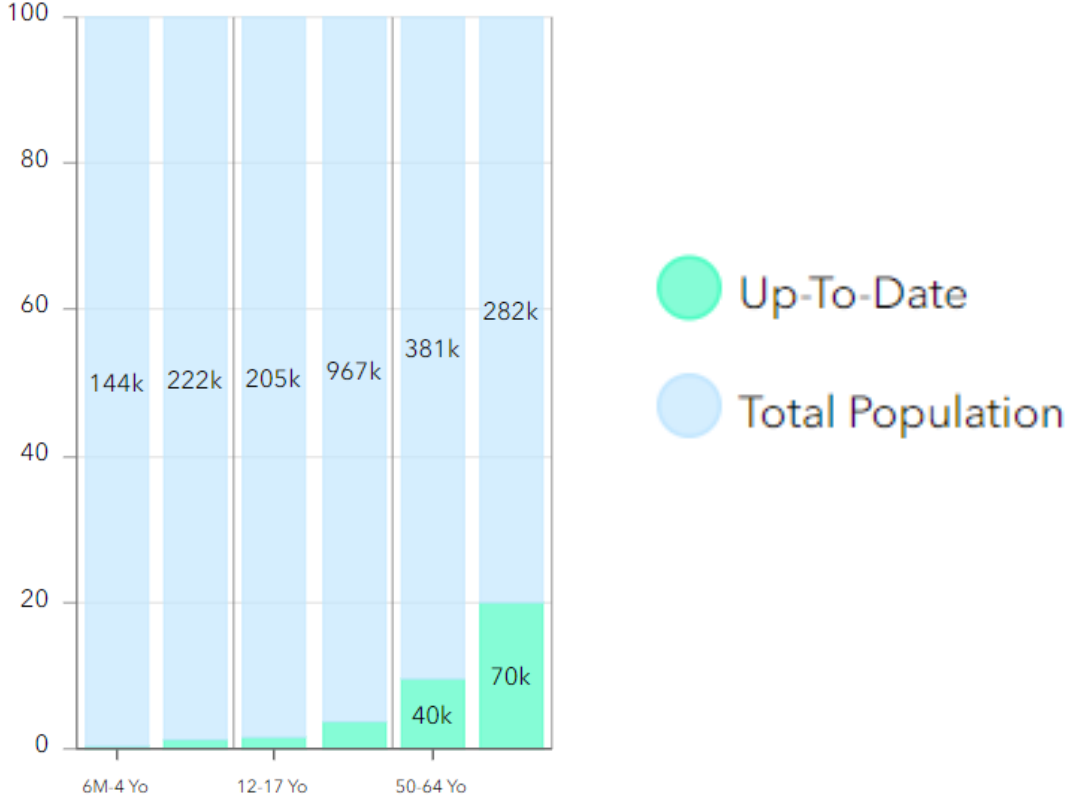
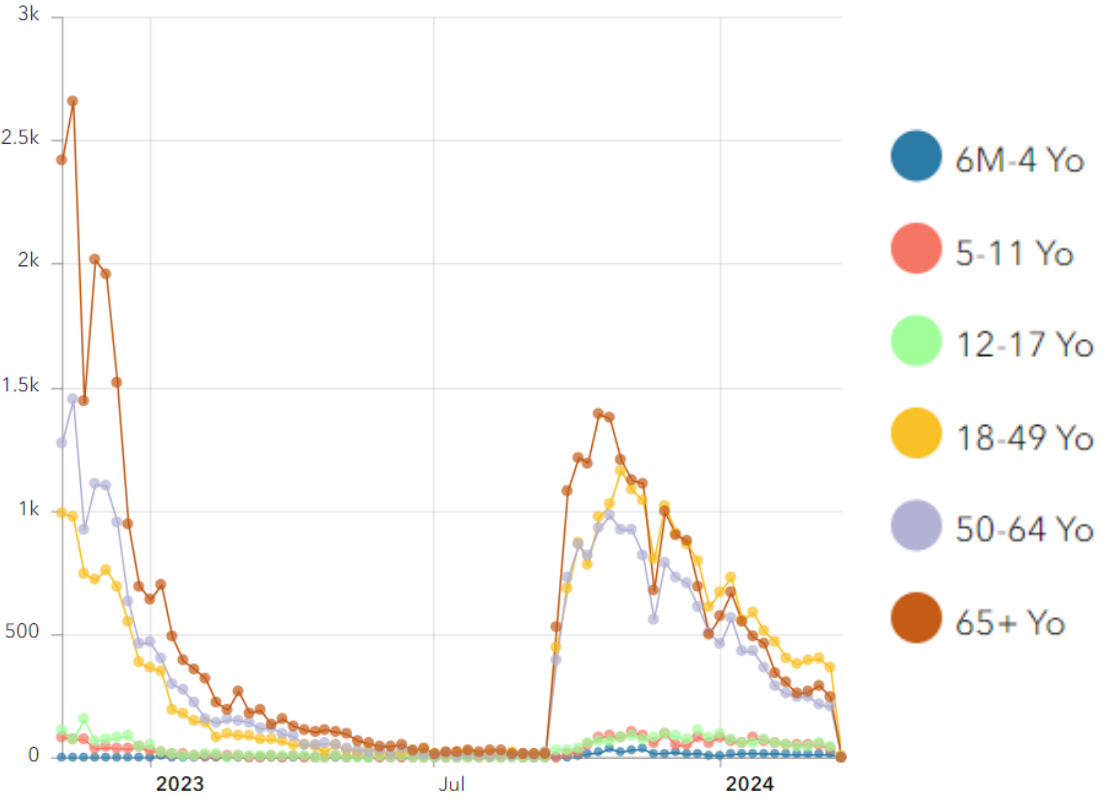

Percent of Residents Up-To-Date by Age Groups

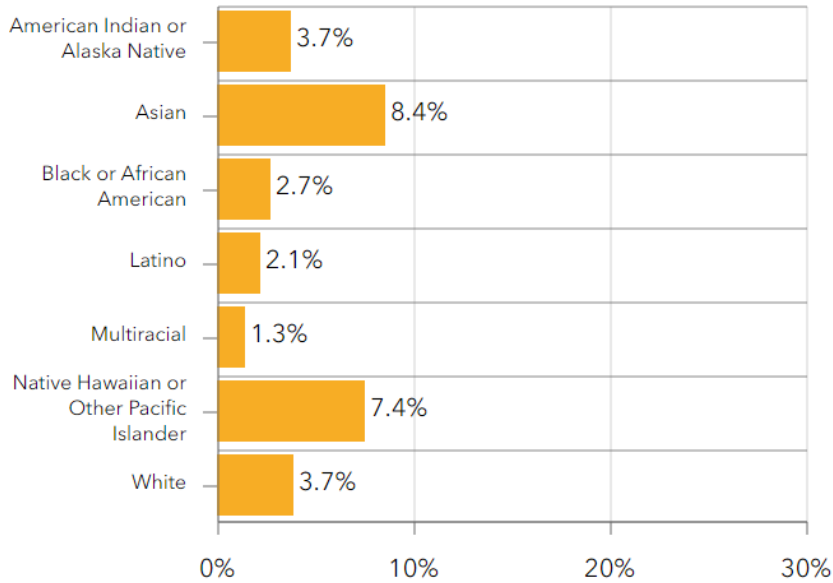

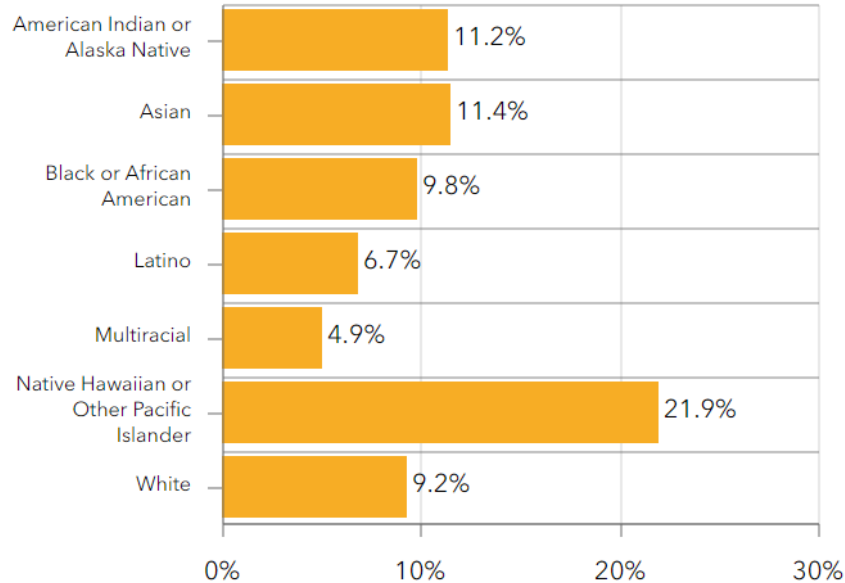

County Vaccination Data by Age and Race/Ethnicity

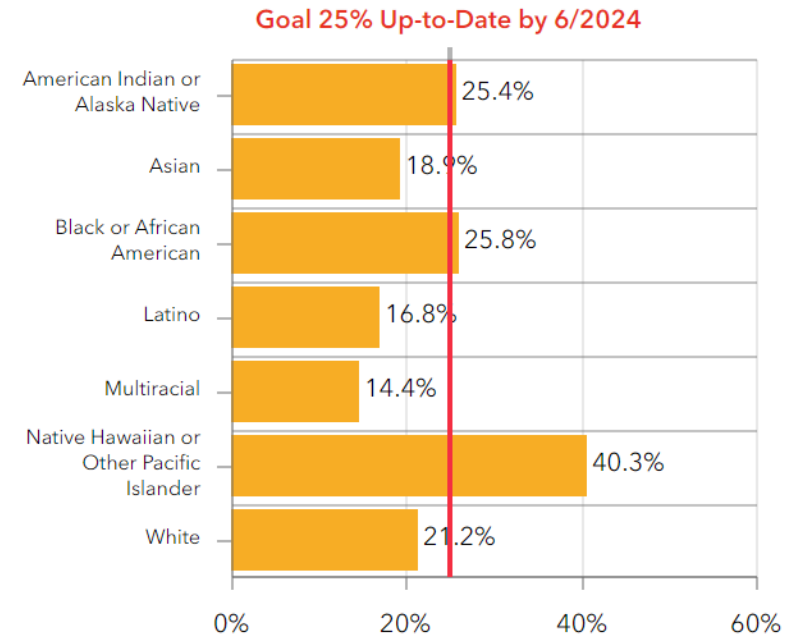

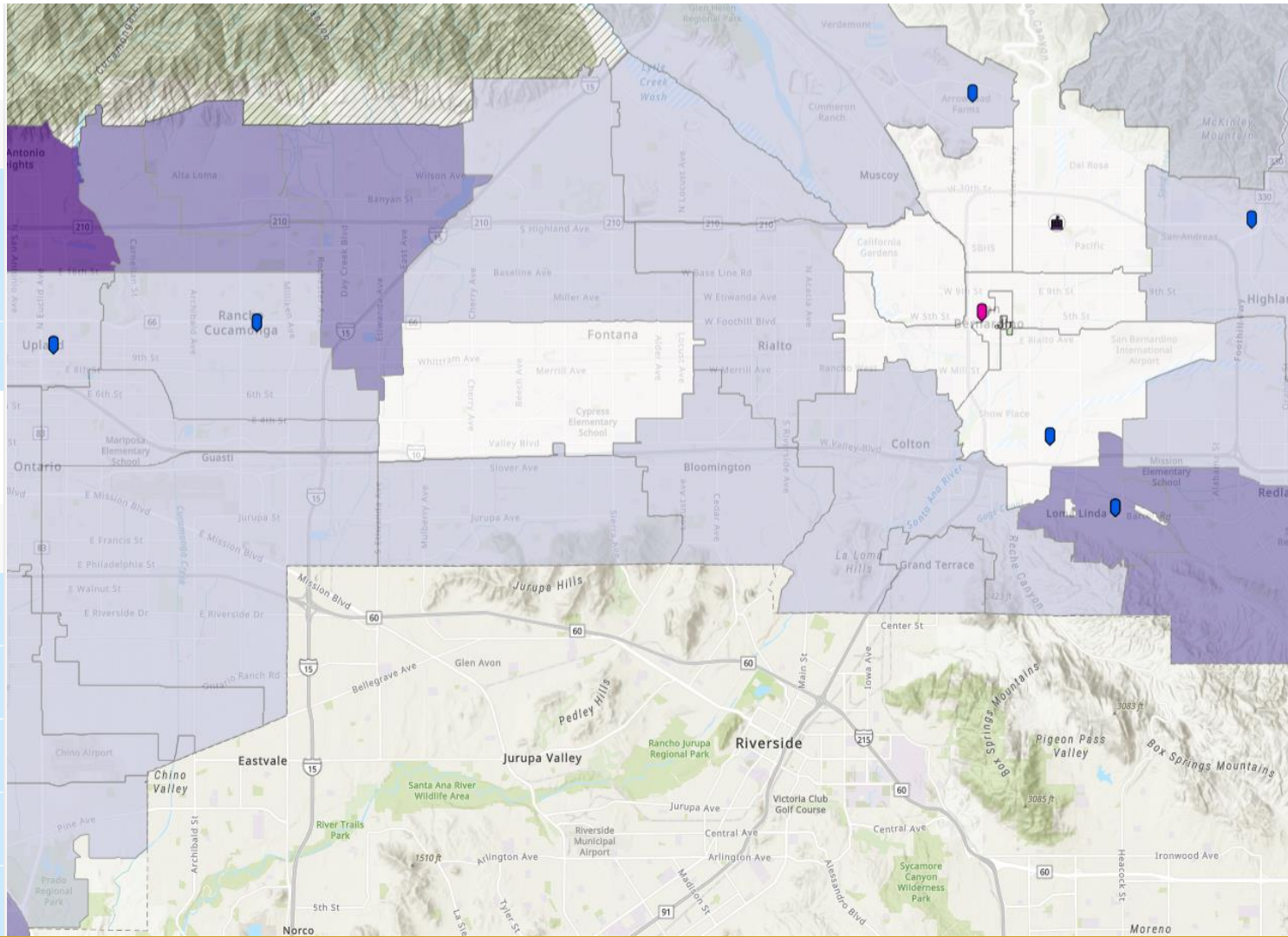

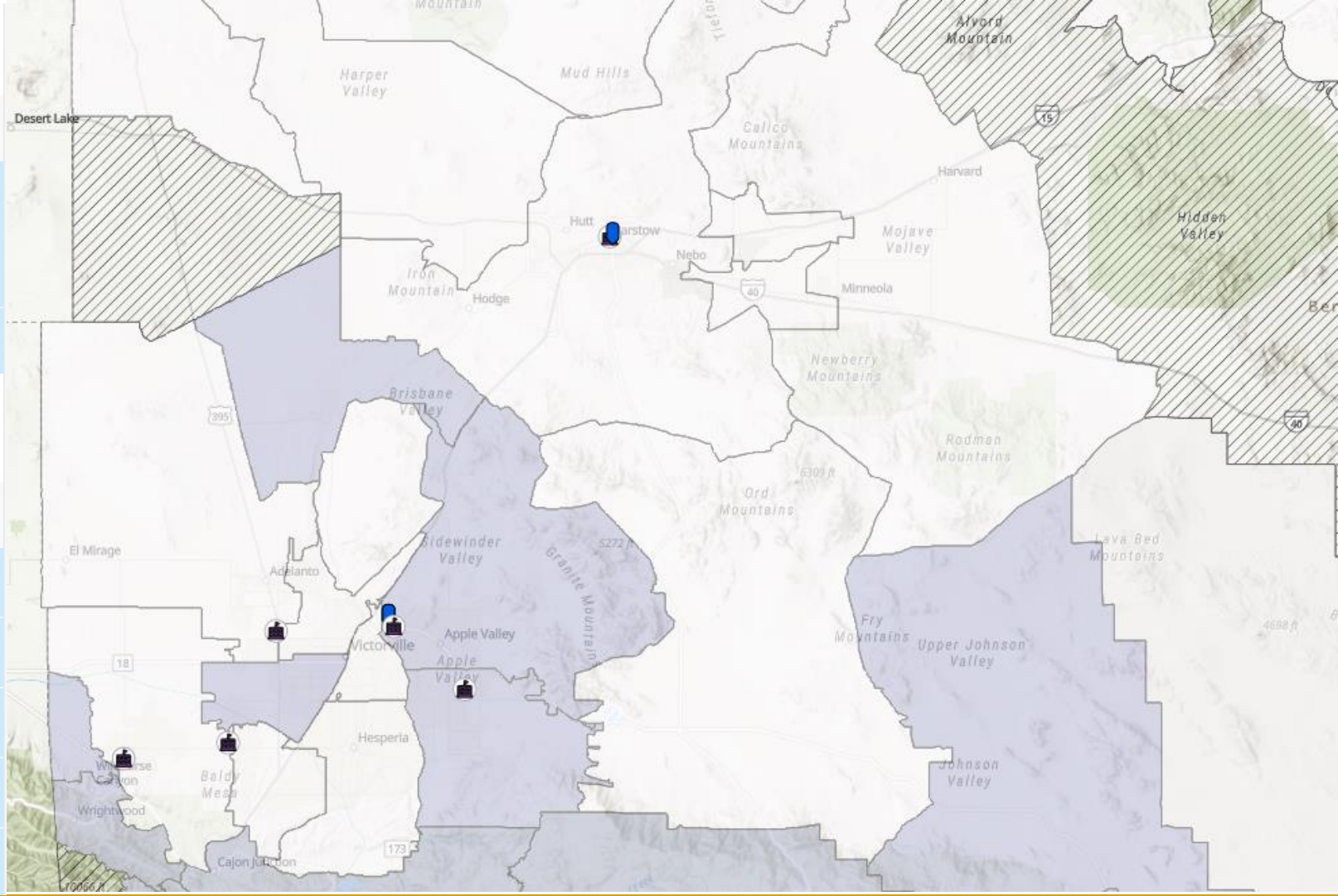

Isolation

Stay home if you have COVID-19 symptoms

Wear a mask

Avoid contact with people at higher risk for severe COVID-19 for 10 days*

- *Infectious period is two days before the date of symptom onset or positive test date.

Seek treatment

Quarantine

If you **have new COVID-19** symptoms:

- Test and wear a mask right away

If you **do not** have any symptoms:

- Test within 5 days IF you are at higher risk of severe COVID-19

If you **do not** have any symptoms **and** are in contact with people at higher risk of severe COVID-19:

- Mask indoors around higher risk people for 10 days

Preparing Children and Families for Their COVID-19 Vaccinations

Hesitancy is normal! Here are a few ways to talk about the vaccine:

1. **Address misinformation**
2. **Share why it is important**
3. **Make the decision together**
4. **Prepare them for the shot**
 1. Communicate
 2. Comfort
 3. Calm
5. **Prepare them for the side effects**
